One is the "Bellerose Inn" located at 249th Street and Jericho Turnpike and the other the "Quality Inn" at 257th Street and Jericho Turnpike. This is not just a local issue but a "City-wide" one. Recently we have all seen the media coverage of the Maspeth residents protesting at their local "Holiday Inn." By the way the owners of that "Holiday Inn" also own the hotels in our neighborhood. It is not that the protestors don't have compassion for the people in these shelters it is the City's arrogance of just placing these people in neighborhoods without informing the local residents, elected officials and the police departments. It may also be something the City can force the hotel owners, if they have vacancies, to house the homeless within their hotels. We need to obtain further information from our elected officials as to what exactly is going on.

# NEIGHBORHOOD BULLETIN: Halloween Safety Tips

- ► Make sure young children are accompanied by an adult or responsible teenager.
- ► Tell children to bring home all of their treats so they can be examined carefully before anything is eaten. Discard any candy or food with a peculiar smell or appearance.
- ▶ Do not allow children to "trick or treat" alone.
- ▶ Do not allow children to wander far from home.
- ▶ Do not permit children to enter buildings or elevators on their own
- ► Tell children to avoid hallways or deserted areas that are dimly lit.
- ► Tell children not to enter a stranger's home or car for the promise of treats.
- ► Remind children to obey the rules at traffic lights and to walk on the sidewalk, not in the street.
- ► Examine all costumes for safety hazards, such as a long costume that could trip a child.
- ▶ Help children choose flame retardant costumes in bright colors or carry a flashlight so that children can be seen by approaching cars.
- Examine masks to be sure a child's vision is unobstructed.
- ► Test makeup on a small patch of skin before applying it to a child's face to make sure that he or she is not allergic.
- ► Give children flashlights, not candles, to carry with them.
- ► Instruct children, if they need help, to look for "SAFE HAVEN" decals in houses and store windows.
