"Queens Community Board 13 (QCB13) welcomes the December 4, 2025, release of the RFP (request for proposals) for the first phase of the redevelopment at Creedmoor. This step brings us closer to realizing our vision to repurpose parts of the Creedmoor campus to best serve the needs of eastern Queens as well as the State and City. Queens Community Board 13 notes how the homes and rental housing in this phase demonstrates the commitment to provide density consistent in scale with eastern Queens and the existing oversaturation of supportive housing in Queens Community Board 13. The community board notes the phase anticipates the move of the SNAP (Services Now for Adult Persons, Inc.) of Eastern Queens Older Adult Center there to a nearby location that still requires significant funding for that to occur within the timeline noted in the RFP. Fully funding the new SNAP Senior Center site in Floral Park remains the number one capital priority of Queens Community Board 13.

Queens Community Board 13, in consultation with its communities, will continue to follow the progress of the RFP to ensure the needs and commitments to our eastern Queens community continue to be met throughout the process."
